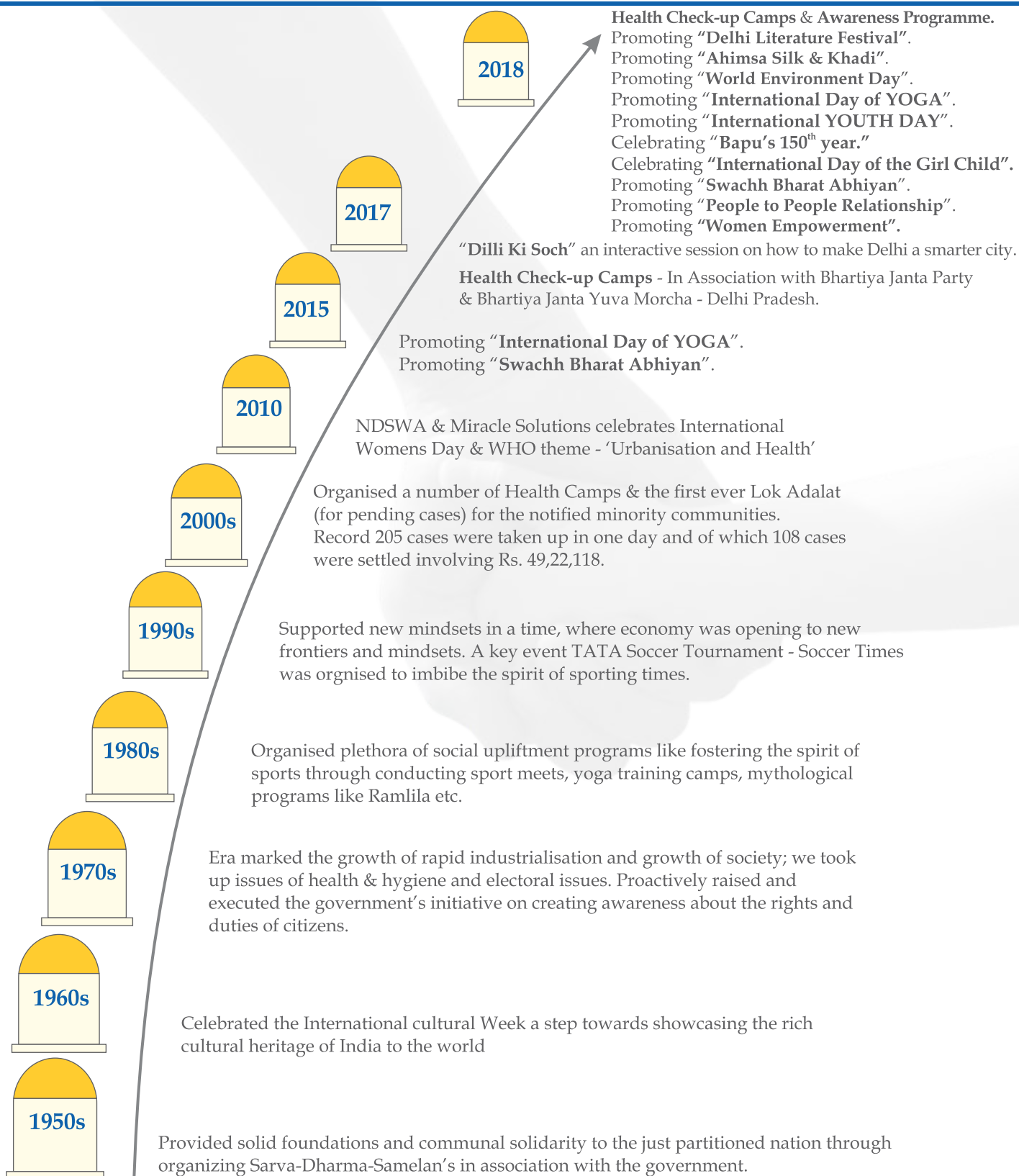

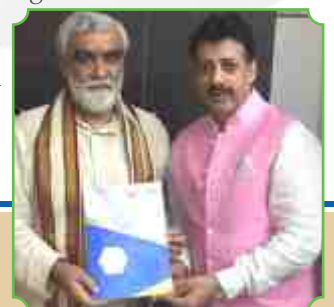
We have been active in the fields of Health. Education, Water Sanitation, Healthy Environment, Women Empowerment, Adult Literacy and other related pursuits of social significance.

Health

As health is the most vital aspect of well being, we have been at the forefront of organising various health camps and workshops from time to time. We catalyse the medical assistance grants to the needy, which includes health check-up camps and distribution of medicines. We coordinate with the Government of India's key nodal agencies as well.

We have also organised AIDS awareness camps, wherein we got NGOs in this field to help and support in counseling the HIV positive people. Actively organising Blood Donation Camps and creating awareness about merits of donating blood to the general public.



Baby and Child Smart

The development of an individual can be best achieved during early years of his/her life. It is during this phase of life when maximum results can be achieved. Based on this, our programs include organizing various camps whereby sensitizing of people, especially mothers, is conducted intensively. Baby and Child Smart Programs are undertaken on regular basis.

Livelihoods

A livelihood comprises of people, their capacities and their means of living. Livelihood must be environmentally sustainable as it provides base for other livelihoods related to it. To create better livelihoods, we study the poor people's livelihoods and factors that shape them. We provide them the necessary relevant tools to strengthen their livelihoods by providing them understanding and opportunities.

One of the best ways to achieve long-term women empowerment is to enable them to work and earn their living on their own. For the purpose we focus on fulfillment of their basic needs. Various steps in this direction include providing day-care facilities, counseling, organizing vocational training camps, etc. We follow the holistic approach so as to make them realize the worth of their economic freedom. We have been organising camps to impart knowledge of self-defence & training girls to handle situations in a better manner.

Community Involvement

If any development project has to gain success, it cannot undermine the importance of community involvement. One of the main parameters to do so is to cultivate the habit of participatory learning and action. We help poor and needy sections to realize the worth of right and meaningful actions. Community involvement programs involve facilitating participatory role of the people in general.



Culture, Social and Sports

To make society healthy and conducive for proper growth and development of an individual, establishing and maintaining coordination within a particular community is a necessary pre-requisite. The best way is to organize sports events from time to time, as this is the best way to bring coherence in a particular society. Most of our members are keen on this and assist to bring the societies closer through organizing co-curricular activities including sports & cultural events.

Water, Sanitation, Environment and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

Water contamination is the most serious health hazard. Equally important is to ensure sanitation of our surroundings. That is how we can make our environment clean and conducive for healthy living. We take this message to the poor and impart ways to ensure clean drinking water, proper sanitation and healthy environment.

Actively interacting with RWAs to create awareness and sensitise people not only about water conservation but how a small change in our water usage habits can help control water borne diseases in our surroundings and how we can adopt protective measures against this menace.

Virtual Village Services

The concept of virtual village is gaining strength and the day is not far when people prefer this way of living. This helps the rural areas gain considerable strength. We provide Virtual Village Services par excellence. The village acts as town side support network as many people can live in these virtual villages setting. We encourage people to understand the concept and imbibe the same.

Computer Aided Learning

This world is characterized by extensive computerization. We assist people to learn the basics of computer, which includes hardware and software skills. Many computer camps have been organized in the past, which has lead to massive training in the fields of computers, creating job opportunities for the needy and deprived sections of our society. Many lives have been changed for the better through Computer Aided Learning Programs.

Adult Literacy

Adult Literacy proves to be vital when it comes to strengthening the society at the root level. Adult Literacy Programs initiated by us constitute imparting the basic literary skills to the adults. Since they do not get time in the morning, we organise these camps when they are free, usually in the later evenings. It helps us to generate confidence and sense of pride in these people and understand their potential of literacy.

Social and Legal Rights

More than 90% of the 10,000 or more cases handled and settled by Sh. Jaswant Rai Grover pertained to persons belonging to the weaker sections of the society residing in J.J. Clusters, Janta flats of the rehabilitation colonies like Sultanpuri and Mongolpuri. The matters were pending for around 10 years or even more and had put unnecessary load of litigation.

Hon'ble Justice Mr. Vijender Jain, Acting Chief Justice, High Court of Delhi and Executive Chairman. DLSA appreciated the efforts and announced to honour Sh. Jaswant Rai Grover, Advocate, for his valuable services and dedication to the cause of ADR system by settling more than 10,000 cases in PLA's / DLSA DHCLSC / Special Lok Adalats Conciliations, which is a landmark in the history of ADR system, under the Legal Services Authority Act 1987.

On the 26th of September 2006 at the Patiala House Court Complex, in a ceremony presided over by the Hon'ble Justice Mr. Vijender Jain, Acting Chief Justice, High Court of Delhi and Executive Chairman DLSA and Hon'ble Justice Dr. M.K. Sharma. Judge, High Court of Delhi and Chairman DHCLSC, Sh. Jaswant Rai Grover was presented with a 'Performance Award' in the august presence of members of the judiciary, members of the Bar Association, officers of the Government of NCT and others.

President of India Hon'ble Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam at the Silver Jubilee Celebration of Delhi Legal Services Authority on 10th November 2006 had said that when he studied the DLSA website ... "The only achievement that I find is the successful settlement of more than 10,000 case pertaining to N.D.P.L., out of court during the period October 2003 to July 2006". This gave us the right lead to conduct Lok Adalats under the guidance of its Hon'ble Chairman Sh. Jaswant Rai Grover.

The first ever Lok Adalat for the notified minorities communities in the National Capital Territory of Delhi was organised by New Delhi Social Workers' Association together with Delhi Legal Services Authority on 23rd August 2009. Held at Tis Hazari and Karkardooma Courts simultaneously; 138 cases were taken up and 77 cases were settled involving an amount of Rs 49,22,118 at the Tis Hazari courts; while 67 cases were taken up and 31 were settled at the Karkardooma courts. Notably, a rare achievement in the legal affairs of Indian judiciary.

Future

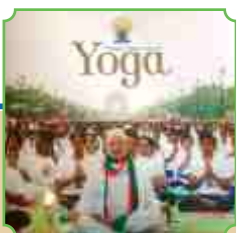
As we stand committed to take the legacy forward and not resting on our laurels, we have re-organised ourselves as a more structured and result - driven organisation — Miracle Solutions.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

2nd June, 2018

New Delhi 2nd June 2018: India is the global host of 2018 World Environment Day. With "Beat Plastic Pollution" as the theme for this year's edition, the world is coming together to combat single-use plastic pollution. World Environment Day is a UN Environment-led global event, the single largest celebration of our environment each year.

Gaurav Grover, President of New Delhi Social Workers Association (NDSWA) with Dr. Udit Raj, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (North West Delhi) along with the **United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP)**, organized a meaningful discussion to create more awareness on environment happening at Constitutional Club of India, Rafi Marg.

The Government of India has committed to organizing and promoting the World Environment Day celebrations through a series of engaging activities and events generating strong public interest and participation. From Pan-Indian plastic clean-up drives in public areas, national reserves and forests to simultaneous beach clean-up activities – India will lead the initiative by setting an example. India is emerging as a leader, given it has one of the highest recycling rates in the world. It can be instrumental in combating plastic pollution. By hosting World Environment Day 2018, the Indian government is accelerating its leadership on an issue of tremendous magnitude. Delhi, the sixth-most populated metropolis in the world (second largest if the entire NCR is included), is one of the most heavily polluted cities in India, having, for instance, one of the country's highest volumes of particulate matter pollution. In May 2014 the World Health Organization announced New Delhi as the most polluted city in the world. Environmental problems in Delhi, are a threat to the well-being of the city's and area's inhabitants as well as the flora and fauna, as it remains one of the most heavily polluted cities. The **New Delhi Social Workers Association (NDSWA)** has been working closely with the Government and the citizens for their societal development and upliftment, for the last six decades.

Mr. Gaurav Grover, President of NDSWA said "This initiative will give an encouragement to all citizens, that they should come forward and fight against the issue of Single-use plastic which is polluting the environment, But this can only happen by individuals taking a step forward, World Environment Day is just a wake-up call for us to work for our environment.

Dr. Udit Raj, Hon'ble Member of Parliament said "We are so conservative that we need everything from our environment without considering how much we are exploiting the earth and damaging the environment. Let us begin with ourselves to fight against the issue of single-use plastic which is polluting the environment. We need to bring the changes in our own pattern of consumption."

Ms. Dia Mirza, Actress & UN Environment Goodwill Ambassador for India said "We are extremely optimistic that we can achieve a significant shift in human behaviour where through the advocacy that we all are involved with, we can help more people to recognise the consumption of single use of plastic and find ways to refuse the single use of plastics. Once we achieve this, we can find a better way to manage the plastic waste."

AHIMSA SILK & KHADI: THE FABRIC OF FREEDOM & HARMONY

"Khadi has the power to provide employment to crores of people. It has now become a symbol and a centre of interest of the nation's youth," Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said in his first 'Mann Ki Baat' address in 2016.

Lauding the people associated with Khadi, he said that the fabric was quickly gaining attention among the youth and was carving a niche for itself in the world of fashion. After the success of Hon'ble Prime Minister Modi's take-yoga-global campaign, it's now the humble Khadi that he wants to take across borders as India peddles its soft power on the international stage. "The Government is aiming at making the 'Khadi' a global product identity of India, as it did for Yoga. A global identity of Khadi would also allow many rural artisans to earn better,"

The Government has already approached the United Nations and sought help in promoting Khadi as a product. The KVIC has now set a bigger target of achieving Rs 5,000 crore in khadi sales by 2018-19. No wonder the Government organisation is now looking at exports. With our Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of further improving the perception, brand building and wider acceptability of our National Fabric-Khadi, along with creating more awareness on the "Swachh Bharat" Campaign, we organized a SHOWCASING with the theme "AHIMSA SILK & KHADI - THE FABRIC OF FREEDOM AND HARMONY" a fashion show on Khadi, in the backdrop of the Indonesian Embassy, New Delhi.
